There is so much to do and see in this area you cannot get it all in ; in just one trip! The Minarets are awesome at sunset!! Devils Postpile, Reds Meadow, Rainbow Falls, Hot Creek; The list goes on and on!! We will be staying in an area that has 5 lakes to fish. Load your buddies and tubes up and pick one. We will do the same 2-fly Event on Saturday AND The Natural Tie Event as well at Saturday's Potluck. At this point I am not sure which lake will be fishing the best to hold the 2 Fly event; time and research will tell. Huge Alpers trout have been planted for years in this area, but since last year the Trout have been coming from Oregon; due to Hatchery issues, i.e., WATER ISSUES. There will be fish and that's all that really matters :)

**DIRECTIONS:** Take US 50 East 77 miles from Hazel; Turn right on CA-89 South 11 miles; Turn left on CA-88E/CA-89 S 12 miles, continue on CA88 N 4.4 miles;Turn right onto NV-756 E/ Centerville rd 1.4 miles (or just stay straight on hwy 88 till right at US 395 South); Turn right on to US-395 South 113 miles; Turn right on Ca-203 West 3.7 miles; Continue straight on Lake Mary Rd 2.3 miles; Slight right onto Twin Lakes Rd, Destination on right. to take the prettier drive over Monitor Pass At Woodfords turn off; turn right CA-89 (Go past Marklee and Carson Resort) Then left on CA-89 DONT MISS THIS LEFT!! Then right on US-395 and follow above directions from there.

Fishing is your standard Trout Flies and Equipment; I will report on that more later; I have to be forgetting something??
