Truckee River Outing

June 23, 24, 25, 2017

EVENT: Truckee River Fishing Trip – Carmel Ski Club

DATE: June 23-25, 2017

SUMMARY: The Truckee Outing is a bit unique in that there are so many different opportunities for fishing that we don't usually all fish the same waters. Within a fifty mile radius of Truckee there are three rivers (the Truckee, the Little Truckee, and the Feather), plus Sagehen, Donner, Prosser and Coldstream Creeks.

There are also a lot of lakes including Martis Lake, Lake Davis, Frenchmen's and Milton Reservoir. There is also Stampede and Boca Reservoirs which are close to Truckee. It may also be possible to arrange to fish on a private lake (Sawmill) by contacting Victor Babbott of Tahoe Fly Fishing Outfitters at 530-545-0193.

On Saturday, Dan LeCount has graciously agreed to take our group on a tour with our own Ken Davis from noon to 3:00pm. He is doing this free of charge! Dan is also available to guide. His rates are \$300 for ½ day for 1 or 2, \$425 for a full day for 1 or 2. One extra person can be added for \$75. His contact information is 530-448-9265.

So just about any type of fishing you might want, this trip has you covered. For first timers we hope to have information on access spots and fishing tips from those familiar with the areas.

MEETING LOCATION: Carmel Ski Club, 11815 Deerfield Drive, Truckee, CA 96161.

I 80 East toward Reno. At exit 185, take ramp right for CA 89 South toward Lake Tahoe. At Roundabout, Take 1st exit onto CA 89 South. Go ½ mile and turn right onto Deerfield Drive. 1 hour, 30 minutes from Roseville

We have space for 20 people. We have reserved Rooms 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 & 10 which have 2 beds each and Rooms 6, 7, & 11 which have 4 beds (2 bunk-beds). We will expect at least double occupancy, so when reserving your room please make sure you have included who you are rooming with.

The cost is **\$26.00** per night prepaid to Mary Ellen Mueller. This includes a housekeeping fee to save our members from having to clean prior to checkout. *Because CFFU has reserved the rooms, if you cancel there are no refunds unless we can fill your space.*

You must bring your own bedding (or sleeping bag), towels and toiletries. There are shared bathrooms (1M, 1F) on the main floor where the rooms are and there are bathrooms with showers as well. No Dogs allowed.

There is a large kitchen and commercial refrigerator if you wish to bring your own food. Please make sure you label everything so there is no confusion about the food. There are two stoves, sinks, and dishwasher. And of course there is a McDonalds 6 blocks away. On **Friday** evening we will have a social in the lounge to share tips of flies or promising locations . And on **Saturday** the club will provide a late afternoon/early evening meal to allow for evening fishing. **Looks like homemade chili and sides!**

For eating there is a very large dining area with 2 long tables. And there is a lounge with TV for socializing. Also a very nice deck and bar with fireplace available for evening cocktails and time for sharing our fish tales.

EQUIPMENT RECOMMENDATIONS: 4-5 wt trout rods, waders, float tubes, boats.
(Hopefully we will have some recommendations for flies etc.)

PARKING: There is limited parking available so carpooling is a good option. We will ask that you park as close as possible to the car next to you. Please make sure not to block any cars in this tight lot. There is some street parking available. Boats and trailers will not fit in the parking lot but street parking may accommodate them.
