Truckee Outing

EVENT: Truckee Fishing Trip at the Carmel Ski Lodge

DATE: June 20-22, 2025

SUMMARY: The Truckee Outing is a bit unique in that there are so many different opportunities for fishing that we don't usually all fish the same waters. Within a fifty mile radius of Truckee there are three rivers (the Truckee, the Little Truckee, and the Feather), plus Sagehen, Donner, Prosser and Coldstream Creeks.

There are also a lot of lakes including Martis Lake, Lake Davis, Frenchmen's and Milton Reservoir. There are also Stampede and Boca Reservoirs which are close to Truckee.

So just about any type of fishing you might want, this trip has you covered. For first timers we will have information on access spots and fishing tips from those familiar with the areas.

MEETING LOCATION: Carmel Ski Lodge, 11815 Deerfield Drive, Truckee, CA 96161.

I 80 East toward Reno. At exit 185, take ramp right for CA 89 South toward Lake Tahoe. At Roundabout, Take exit onto CA 89 South. Go ½ mile and turn right onto Deerfield Drive. Proceed on Deerfield Drive for approximately 1 mile to 11815 Deerfield Drive. The lodge is on the left side.

There is limited parking available so carpooling is a good option. We ask that you park as close as possible to the car next to you. Please make sure not to block any cars in this tight lot. There is some street parking available. Boats and trailers will no fit in the parking lot but street parking may accommodate them.

LODGE DESCRIPTION

On one side of the first floor you'll find our large kitchen, fitted with an oversized refrigerator, an industrial sized stove and oven, a sink and two dishwashers, and ample counter space for food prep. A large open pantry provides storage for non-perishables. The adjoining dining area has two large tables which can accommodate large crowds, making the perfect setting for our Saturday afternoon luncheon. A family-room area with relaxed seating for television watching completes this side of the first floor. By the half-bathroom on the opposite end of the first floor is a spacious social area with fireplace and comfortable seating for gathering together and sharing our fishing stories. The room's attached patio affords an opportunity for star-gazing by night or just soaking in the relaxing Truckee ambience by day.

The bedrooms are located on the second floor. Some bedrooms have two twin beds while others have two twins and bunk beds. There are two large bathrooms, male & female. Each bathroom has a private shower area, multiple sinks and multiple stalls.

ROOM OCCUPANCY REQUIREMENT

We have reserved space for 20 people at the lodge. We require double occupancy per room, so when reserving your room please make sure you have included who you are rooming with.

THINGS TO BRING

You must bring your own bedding, pillows, linens, blankets or sleeping bags. You must also supply your own towels, wash cloths and toiletries. If you want to bring your own food, the lodge has a large refrigerator to accommodate that. Because there may be several people bringing food please make sure you label everything so there is no confusion about the food. And of course the other option is the McDonalds on the corner of Deerfield Drive and CA 89 South.

SOCIAL HOUR AND CLUB AFTERNOON MEAL

On Friday & Saturday evening we will have a Margareta social hour in the living room. Also on Saturday Guy will provide a late afternoon meal in the dining room at 1:00 PM. During that time for those that are new to the area we have experienced fly fishermen to share tips on flies or promising locations.

GUEST SPEAKER

Miles Zimmerman and his brother Austin of Trout Creek Outfitters will be giving us a presentation on Saturday June 21 at 2:00 PM. This will be after the BBQ and held in the social area of the Lodge. They are managers for Trout Creek Outfitters in Truckee. Their presentation will be in two parts. The first part will be how to fish the notoriously difficult Truckee River. They will share with us some tips to catch more fish. The second part of the presentation will be about their shop and what they have to offer.

COST AND PAYMENT DEADLINES

The cost is \$40.00 per night, \$80.00 total for two nights, prepaid to Sam Seaton. This includes a housekeeping fee to save our members from having to clean prior to checkout. *Because Sam Seaton has reserved the rooms, no refund after June 3, 2025. If you cancel after June 3rd there are no refunds unless you can fill your space.*

Participants need to pre pay within 5 days of signing up. Otherwise your name will be dropped from the list.
